

LONG RANGE MAINTENANCE OF BUILDING AND GROUNDS

This school district operates in accordance with its strategic plan, which is reviewed annually and revised as necessary to address specific actions to improve the quality of education provided by the District.

The Board of Trustees shall be the custodian of real and tangible school property and shall manage, control, and care for same, both during the school term and during vacation. The grounds shall be adequately maintained and requirements for ongoing upkeep shall be reviewed on a monthly basis.

The Superintendent or his designee will develop a process to manage repairs and communication regarding work order processing, work prioritization and management, reporting, and quality assurance.
