

TRAFFIC AND PARKING CONTROLS

Section I: STUDENT SAFETY

The superintendent or designee shall, with the Campus Enforcement, Jackson Police Department and other appropriate agencies, provide the best possible safety coverage for students leaving and entering the school grounds. This safety coverage will include the use of safety patrols and the marking of school speed zone areas as provided by law.

Section II: PARKING

The superintendent or designee shall develop regulations relative to parking and traffic controls on all school property.

Section III: ACCIDENTS INVOLVING SCHOOL DISTRICT VEHICLES

All accidents which result in personal injury or property damage, and which involve vehicles owned by the school district, shall be reported in written form to the employee's immediate supervisor who, in turn, shall report to the designee of the superintendent.

All accidents will be reviewed by the superintendent or designee. If it is found that there has been negligence on the part of the driver, the accident report and the findings will be submitted to the superintendent or designee for appropriate disciplinary action.
